RCA General Synod 2021

Voted to form a Restructuring Team for the denomination to consider the following:

- Reorganizing each Classis around affinity, rather than geography.
- Keep responsibility for decisions related to ordination and marriage up to each Classis.
- Adopt a generous separation policy when churches leave the RCA over the next five years.
- Consider the disbanding of regional synod assemblies.






SUNDAY SCHOOL | Question of the day?
