#### FOLLOWING CHRIST IN MISSION

The Reformed Church in America is a fellowship of congregations called by God and empowered by the Holy Spirit to be the very presence of Jesus Christ in the world.

This is our vision. This is our mission. But,

We live in a broken world. Individuals are broken. Institutions are broken. Jesus said, "Where two or more are gathered in my name there I am in the midst of them." Well, at the same time, where two or more are gathered, there is also the capacity and opportunity for conflict. Such is the state of our human condition. Such is the state of our denomination.

There has always been conflict, but our most recent conflict focuses on the debates around human sexuality. The impasse here is so deep and nonnegotiable that our denomination has resolved to strike a new path forward. A Vision Team was put together to help with this revisioning, and after two years of meeting, they have written up a report for consideration at General Synod next summer. While the recommendations sent to GS are subject to change and are also contingent upon Classes approval, the three points of the Report are given here so that the whole Bethany community can be aware of the conversations that are going on. *No changes are in store for at least a couple of years, but nevertheless, the thought process begins now.* Here is a summary:

#### [1] Stay together yet change structure

- The primary structure of the RCA involves fleets of churches divided up by geography. These
  fleets are called Classes. Thus, we are a part of MN Classis. Change #1 would reconfigure this
  structure from geography to affinity. An affinity classis then, would be based not on location, but
  on similar interests and vision.
- Regional Synods would be largely disbanded and/or consolidated

#### [2] Create new mission agency

The RCA has a strong missional identity. In order to preserve this heritage, the Vision 2020
Team has recommended the formation of a new mission agency. The agency would be
independent / non-denominational, but would allow churches continue supporting the
missionaries of their choice.

#### [3] Mutually generous separation

Individual churches could leave graciously, with no hassle, and retain their property.
