2 Peter 3:5

From Harvard's "Rules and Precepts," adopted in 1646:

Let every Student be plainly instructed, and earnestly pressed to consider well, the maine end of his life and studies is, to know <u>God</u> and <u>Jesus</u> Christ which is eternal life (<u>John 17:3</u>) and therefore to lay Christ in the bottome, as the only foundation of all sound knowledge and Learning. And seeing the Lord only giveth wisedome, Let every one seriously set himself by prayer in secret to seeke it of him (<u>Prov. 2:3</u>).


