My Story. By Anna Marie Seeman

I was born on November 11, 1927 on the Iowa / MN border. My father, Ben Hinrichs, drowned in 1929. After that, we moved to Raymond to a small farm and lived at Grandmother Getting. I had whooping cough in 1930 and was fed bananas and jello. During this time, Grandma taught me how to sew. In 1932 we had no rain. The result was no crop and a dust storm.

In 1934, my mother remarried John F. Asche. We moved north of Clara City in 1936. Over the next year I had trouble with a boil in my ear and had ear infections. To make matters worse, while visiting relatives we were exposed to small pox and had to quarantine. Soon, they discovered a small pox vaccine.

In 1937 I had my tonsils and adenoids removed. We had no inside running water and no electricity on the farm until 1938. While on the farm I made an attempt to milk cows. During one of my attempts, I fell into the gutter and injured my ankle. I developed an infection which required surgery. The surgeon was a WWI vet. He cleaned up my leg, but at this time there were no antibiotics so I had my leg in a cast. The doctor had no nurse to help him so when he needed help, he would set his equipment on my lap and I would hand him the tools he needed. During my recovery I kept busy sewing and making quilt tops.

This is probably where I discovered the importance of being satisfied with what I had. My faith in God started when I lived with Grandmother Dora. She took me to Salem Reformed Church in Little Rock, IA. She was a Sunday school teacher. She had sewn me a pretty red dress and told me to sit and wait while she taught her class. She gave me a card with the lesson on it. One part had a picture of Jesus and beautiful flowers in a garden. I would not give the card back as it was where I wanted to go. When we were home, she would say, "It's Tea Time!" and we would talk about the Bible and she explained to me what each part on her lesson card meant.

The best thing I found out from the Bible as I grew up was about God's grace. I studied and read the Bible and found out He is with me, keeps me through all the problems I face and shows me his love. And, I do love Him as He also guides me when I have problems. I can talk with Him daily, and I do.

These are difficult times, indeed. I was born in 1927 and have survived many things including the death of my father at age two, whopping cough, the dust storm of 1932, the Great Depression, WWII, small pox quarantine, no running water & electricity until I was 11 years old, polio, osteomyelitis infection, and reoccurring ear infections for which the care was minimal. I have learned in my long life . . . the art of being satisfied and have gained knowledge that God is with me, helping me through any problems I may have. I love Him and talk to Him often. He has helped me with all the challenges in my life, and He will see us through Covid-19!
